The Centre was founded in 2002—thanks to EU funding—with the aim to develop educational activities, research and interdisciplinary training on the issues of human rights protection. The EIUC has its roots in Europe, but a global vision. It is the hub for a network of over 100 universities (Global Campus of Master's Programmes and Diplomas in Human Rights and Democratisation) representing the EU member states and university networks in Asia, Africa, Latin America, the Caucasus Region and South East Europe: institutions and partners that make the EIUC/GC a unique institution.

The Institution aims to contribute broadly to the dissemination of a shared global knowledge of human rights and democracy. It is located at the Monastery of San Nicolò in the Venice Lido, sharing with the town its ambition to become a European Capital of Human Rights.

Among the educational and training programmes, there are:

- The **European Master in Human Rights and Democratisation (EMA)**, which is in its twentieth year;
- The **Arab Master in Democracy and Human Rights**;
- The **Venice School of Human Rights**;
- The **Venice Academy of Human Rights**;
- The **Summer School in Cinema Human Rights and Advocacy**;
- Training seminars on specific issues, such as the Role and the Law of the **European Court of Human Rights** and the **International Election Observation**.

The Institution works with several international partners including the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights, UNESCO, the Council of Europe and the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights.

Through the network of the Centre's collaborations, the graduates have excellent career prospects through internships and fellowships. The institution has internship agreements with the following: the Ministries of Foreign Affairs of Austria, Belgium, Britain, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Italy, Poland, Portugal and Slovenia; the Delegations of the European Union in Strasbourg, Tel Aviv and Khartoum; the European Union Agency for Fundamental rights; the UN High Commissioner for Human rights; UNESCO; the Organization for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE); the offices of Strasbourg, Belgrade and Sarajevo of the Council of Europe; Human Rights Watch; the International Commission of Jurists; No Peace Without Justice; the International Rehabilitation Council for Torture Victims offices in Brussels and Copenhagen; the World Organisation Against Torture; the Norwegian Refugee Council; the ADA in Luxembourg and the International Organization for Migration in Beijing. As for the programme of fellowships, selected

graduates are hosted by the European Union Delegation to the United Nations, respectively in Geneva and New York.

The EIUC/GC participates in **research activities** through various programmes such as FP7-FRAME, ACTIONES and the United Nations Global Study on children deprived of liberty. It also organises publications and research studies involving the partner universities, as well as hosting researchers at its premises.

The EIUC/GC facilitates the integration of the training activities of the Regional Master Programmes through the exchange of **professors, researchers and students**; It promotes global research projects; disseminates the activities, encourage professional development of graduates through internship programs with international organisations, with particular attention on the **Global Campus Alumni Association** and the individual associations of which is composed, representing more than 3500 alumni.

Among the joint activities to the seven Regional Master's Programmes include:

- **Global Campus field trips**;
- Publication and dissemination of selected and awarded **theses**;
- Six-month **internships** in international organisations for selected students;
- **Scholarships**;
- **E-journal**: an online academic journal where analyses, critical reports and comments on recent developments related to human rights and democratisation are published;
- **MOOC** (Massive Open Online Courses): training courses on human rights held by academics and experts from all regions of the world.

The **library** has 14,200 volumes that can be accessed through the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC), 230 e-books, 1577 published theses from the European Master in Human Rights and Democratisation, subscriptions to 100 journals and an International Law database.

The EIUC/GC is present on Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn and Google+, with a monthly reach of more than 200,000 users.

The website, www.eiuc.org, now ranks among the 400,000 most visited websites in the world and the 22,000 most visited websites in Belgium, home to many of the partner institutions.
